Nurse's Corner

April is Stress Awareness Month



Feeling STRESSED?? Yipes, can I relate to this topic! Can anyone reading this relate to feeling a little stressed-out at times?? How appropriate that there is even a month designated to address this issue!!

Stress can be felt differently for each individual. While one may be stressed easily in a given situation, another manages the stress better. Stress causes anxiety and when anxiety goes 'too far' it becomes paralyzing or inhibits the actives of daily living. It is important to "de-stress", especially when it becomes severe enough to affect your day-to-day life.

Here are some tips for reducing stress:

- Take 5 minutes and sit quietly, eyes closed, and breathe slow and deep
- Prioritize the most important things you need to do
- Don't "sweat the small stuff"

- Come to Church! People who come attend church often cope with stress better



April Book of the Month


